Officiant

Member of the clergy - donation City Hall - civil officiant - do not tip them it's against the law

How much? Between \$50-\$100 When? The day before or immediately after the ceremony

Photographer

Photographer Photographer Assistant Videographer

How much? Between 5% - 10% anywhere between \$300 and \$500 and \$50 - \$100 for the second shooter

When? End of the wedding night

Offsite Catering & Waitstaff

This only applies if you are using an external catering company. These tips will generally be included in the wedding package at your destination wedding resort.

How much? Between 15% - 20% of the total cost

When? At the end of the reception

Bartenders

This only applies if you are using an external bartending company or at an offsite venue. These tips will generally be included in the wedding package at your destination wedding resort.

How much? A few dollars per guest **When?** At the end of the reception

Hair & Makeup

Hair Stylist for you and the bridal party Makeup artist for you and the bridal party **How much?** 20% of the total cost **When?** Upon completion of services

Entertainment

Ceremony musicians Reception Band DJ Sound Technician

How much? Between \$25-\$50 per musician for a band; at least \$200 for a DJ **When?** At the end of the reception

Venue Staff

This only applies if you are using an external venue. These tips will generally be included in the wedding package at your destination wedding resort.

How much? 15%- 2 0% of the pre-tax amount

When? At the end of the reception

Drivers

How much? 15%- 2 0% of the pre-tax amount

When? At the end of the final ride of the day

Florist

How much? 10%of the pre-tax total **When?** At the end of the reception

Wedding Planner

How much? Between \$250 - \$1000 depending on scope of service
When? At the end of the reception

On-Site Coordinator

How much? Between \$100 - \$200 When? At the end of the reception

Tipping quide

Tipping may fluctuate depending on the country, but here are some general guidelines to help you while you are travelling for your honeymoon. Of course there are some resorts, like Sandals where tipping is not expected, except for the butler and spa personnel. Keep in mind that these are merely guidelines, and tipping is at the discretion of the individual.

At the Airpot

Skycap \$1 per bag Taxi Driver 10-15% of fare

Limo Driver 15-20% depending on service

At the Hotel

Bellman \$1 per bag, \$1 for room tour Front desk \$5 for early or late check-in Butler \$100 - \$150 per week Maid \$2 to \$5 per day Room Service 15% to 20% of a bill

Concierge

• Special treatment upon arrival \$10 to \$20 • Simple Advice or Directions not necessary • Last Minute Restaurant Reservations \$5 to \$10 Personal Shopping \$20 to \$50 Parking Attendant \$2 to \$3 after car is delivered

Pool Attendant \$2 per day for a chair \$1

At the Spa

Massage Therapist 10% to 20% of final bill Hair Stylist 10% to 20% Manicurist or Esthetician 15% Barber \$2 to \$3

At the Restaurant

Waiter 15% to 20% of bill Buffet \$1 to \$2 per person Maitre D \$5 to \$10 for a table Musician \$2 to \$3 for special requests

On the Go

Tour Guide \$2 to \$5/day or 10%-15% of tour price **Bus Driver** \$2 per person plus \$1 per bag

Wedding

Waitstaff 15% to 20% of total bill Bartender 10% of bill, or \$1 per drink Officiant Nor required or no more than \$100
